### dear church,

It's exciting to see God working throughout the world and building up His church! Yet, if I could critique the modern method of church growth I would address the overemphasis on musicality and the lack of emphasis on mentoring (or apprenticing/discipleship). The rise of Christian music has enamored many in the church world with the talents and marketing capabilities of churches. I mean, why not? If we can reach millions with music that speaks about Jesus, then why wouldn't we...I'd offer this reason as a caution, that in focusing too much on one way to worship we risk repeating history and continuing to reject the command of Jesus. In this method, we are in danger of reaching many and disciplining few. Yet Jesus discipled a few to reach the many. We also run the risk of abandoning Jesus' call to disciple entirely. Even still, it's much easier to please people with great music and great teaching than it is to do the hard work of apprenticeship (discipleship) and biblical counseling. Church would be relatively smooth if no one ever shared their grueling struggles with sin and painful resulting effects. But that wouldn't be church.

Don't get me wrong though! We ought to use music for the glory of God to communicate the truth and beauty of the gospel in a way that words alone cannot. Music stirs up our affections and emotions for God and His glory. Music is a uniting force of fellowship amongst the faithful, expressing our gratitude and praise and our lament and supplication. These are good things, but they are a component of worship, not all of worship. Discipleship teaches others how to worship through life and in one way, through music.

I write to you in hopes that we view church with the wonder of worship through music and the dedication of discipleship through groups and biblical counseling. That we would recognize this is not a football game or concert venue to be entertained, but a hospital for sinners. This is not a place for your pleasure or anyone's glory; this is a place for God to do spiritual surgery on our broken hearts. So, would you consider stepping into a life group, or DGroup leadership, or biblical counseling/soul care? Would you see Sunday morning as the opportunity to feed God your first fruits rather than seeking to be fed more in our overly saturated and resource abundant society?

My friend and brother in Christ often says in consideration of musicality in the church, "Less is more." The reason this is true...less of me results in more of God. So in my worst of days I am a glory-stealing thief unsatisfied with anything, and on the days I recognize my deep desire for the God of grace I am wholly satisfied in Him. Less is more.

#### Why is Mauritania on the World Watch List?

Any deviation from Islamic belief is strongly opposed in communities and through family pressure. Pressure on converts from Islam to Christianity can be very high, particularly in rural areas where tribal and family ties are especially strict. Violent Islamic extremist groups, like al-Qaeda in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM) and Movement for Unity and Jihad in West Africa (MUJAO), are particularly active in the country's eastern border regions.

#### How can I pray with Christians in Mauritania?

Pray for the secret believers of Mauritania as they seek to worship God. Pray for a new openness toward religious expression among government officials. Ask God to open their hearts. Pray that God would provide creative ways for believers to find and support each other in their difficult walk of faith. Ask God to allow more churches to open in Mauritania, and to allow the churches that do exist to worship without fear. Slavery is still rampant in Mauritania. Ask God to overturn this vile practice and to help enslaved people find Him. Conversion to Christianity from Islam is illegal, and carries with it a sentence of death (though no one has actually been executed for this). Pray for any seekers scared of what it means to choose Jesus. Pray that God will strengthen Christians who risk an accusation of blasphemy at every turn.
