

dear church,

"Above all, you know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from the prophet's own interpretation, because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." (2 Peter 1:20–21, CSB)

God spoke scripture into existence through humans. How gracious is our God to speak through broken people with broken languages? God loves you enough to communicate in the language of His people. Over time that truth was passed down from the original language to our own language! We should all give thanks to God for access to His Word in our language.



My intent in writing to you is to remind us that our truth is founded on God's Word and not on our own. Truth comes from His Word and not our own interpretation of His Word or our own words detached from His Word. We might have wonderful illustrations and insights, but ultimately the truth is derived from God's Word communicated through authors.

If this is true, then no preacher or teacher should teach a truth outside of scripture. It's easy for us to confuse what we read or hear from humans with what we have from God. Be intentional about deriving your theology and practice in life from God's Word and not from human words.

Here is a good question I ask often: is this derived from God's Word, is this derived from someone teaching me God's Word, or is this derived from someone's own words?



Why is Algeria on the 2023 World Watch List?

While Christians make up a tiny percentage of the population of Algeria, they face increasing obstacles to religious freedom. Laws regulating non-Muslim worship ban anything that would "shake the faith of a Muslim" or be used as "a means of seduction intending to convert a Muslim to another religion."

How can I pray with Christians in Algeria?

Pray for churches that have been closed to reopen, and for laws forbidding religious freedom to be repealed. Ask God to bring release for Christians arrested or detained for something as simple as selling Christian books. Pray for the leadership of Algeria, that they would be open to religious freedom for people of all faiths. Pray that Algerian Christians who've converted from Islam will be protected from harassment, violence and rejection.


THINKING GROUPS?
