dear church,

During the time of Jesus, a fishing net was circular and had weights around it. With sweat pouring down their face, arms exhausted, and sand crunching between their toes they would cast this net over and over. Usually, they caught nothing. Fishing license in hand, Peter would set out to sea with the boys and fish. Exhausted and desperate for a catch to provide for the family when fishing provided so little financially during the Roman Empire's reign, they often set sail with Jesus.

Fishing, traveling...and miracles. Now, remember, these guys have been fishing since they were young; it was a family practice. They were tough. But in a violent storm, they were afraid and Jesus hits them with a truth bomb and shows them that they fear creation rather than the creator. (Mark 4:37–38, CSB)

And, when they were on the sea another time, they were afraid of what they thought was a ghost, spoiler it was Jesus! (Matthew 14:26, CSB) But Peter wants more. He wants proof without faith, and he tells Jesus to make him walk on water too. So Jesus makes Peter walk on water. But, proof without faith will always lead to fear. So Peter sinks in the water because he had the proof but lacked the faith. Careful here, because knowledge of God without faith in God is the most dangerous place on earth. Yet right beyond that fear is faith that can move mountains. You see, Peter needed to face the fear of death before he could change the world with the gospel message. No amount of fishing, or sailing, or manliness was good enough to prevent fear in Peter's life. He needed to learn a lesson that Jesus would teach him over and over: fear often hides faith. And faith unleashes warriors for the kingdom. Are you hiding behind fear? Have faith in Jesus.



MAIN RELIGION: Islam





Why is Morocco on the World Watch List?

In Morocco, Christians who talk to others about their faith risk arrest and prosecution—due to the country's law that criminalizes "shaking the faith of a Muslim." This year, several believers were forced to leave the country. Life for Christians in Morocco remains very difficult.

How can I pray with Christians in Morocco?

Pray with isolated believers in Morocco who must sustain their faith alone or risk house arrest, physical attacks, arrest and imprisonment. Pray for tolerance of faiths other than Islam in Moroccan society, with freedom to gather. Pray for wisdom and discernment for secret believers as they secretly gather for fellowship. Pray for house church leaders' safety. Pray that God would give them vision for new believers and a passion to disciple them. Pray for literacy. Morocco has the world's oldest university founded in 859 AD; yet only three- fourths of the country can read and write.
