James 4:1-2 "What is the source of wars and fights among you? Don't they come from your passions that wage war within you? 2 You desire and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and wage war. You do not have because you do not ask."

Don't Avoid Confrontation and Conflict.

Ephesians 4:26-27 "Be angry and don't sin – Don't let the sun go down on your anger and don't give the devil an opportunity."

Speak the Truth Always in Love.

Words Matter.


Proverbs 15:1 "A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs up wrath."


