

dear church,

The phrase, “do not be afraid,” is used 30 times in the CSB Bible. In the KJV it is translated as, “fear not.” The phrase can be used in a context where fear should not exist at all, like:

“After these events, the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield; your reward will be very great.” (Genesis 15:1, CSB)

In this sense, Abram should delight in the words of God because God is his protector. Yet, Abram feels like God is dangerous because of the overwhelming reality of a finite being following an infinite God. Abram truly should not fear the Lord in this way. Note that in other situations the fear of the Lord is appropriate, but it is a different type of fear. The phrase can also be used when fear is rational but should not stop action. For instance:

“Haven’t I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”” (Joshua 1:9, CSB)



a word from the pastor

Many humans would fear an enemy in battle, but Joshua is to have a courage not in himself but in the Lord. Often times our courage is not in our own abilities, but in the faithfulness of God to work through us. We can face situations that we could not overcome and have confidence that we will overcome because the Lord is with us. Notice that Joshua should not be afraid because “the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” Even when fear seems like the rational response, we often have courage because God is with us.

Are you facing a difficult situation and you are afraid? So was Joshua when he could see the promise land but also the people occupying that land. He could see what was right, but also what was dangerous. In life, we must make the decision in the face of danger to be courageous. My hope is that you will discern when God is calling you to be courageous because He is with you, and when God is calling you out of a battle you should not be fighting.

Have courage to fight the right fight, and God will be with you.





Individuals can go through training to work with expecting moms.


