Church Family, God is Good - Amen? Amen! One of the ways that God shows His goodness in our lives is through community and the brothers and sisters He puts in our lives. It has been my joy to share our leadership training this past week and then preaching on the importance of community to carry out God's plan in our lives.

Romans 12:3-8 teaches us that we must first not think of ourselves more highly than we should. Paul then tells us that the body of Christ is made up of many different parts and those parts, which are us and the gifts God has given us, are for God's Glory and our good. He gives us gifts like teaching, leading and service to not only grow each other but also to care for one another. Let's take a look at how God uses community in our lives to accomplish His plan in lives.

"For by the grace given to me, I tell everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he should think. Instead, think sensibly, as God has distributed a measure of faith to each one. Now as we have many parts in one body, and all the parts do not have the same function, in the same way we who are many are one body in Christ and individually members of one another. According to the grace given to us, we have different gifts: if prophecy, use it according to the proportion of one's faith; if service, use it in serving; if teaching, in teaching; if exhorting, in exhortation; giving, with generosity; leading, with diligence; showing mercy, with cheerfulness." Romans 12:3-8 (CSB)

God uses community to grow us spiritually:

- Community plays a crucial role in our growth and discipleship.
- In community, is how Jesus discipled others the 12 and the 3.
- Hebrews 10:24-25 tells us that we are to "spur one another on to love and good deeds."
 And that we should not forget to meet with each other
- It is with a group of believers that we are challenged, we can be vulnerable, and we can grow.

God provides wise counsel through community:

- Outside of the church, where will you find truth?
- Inside the church is where we will find Biblical wisdom, Biblical truth, and Biblical knowledge.
- It is hard to find wise counsel when you are not part of a group.
- Wise counsel comes from having a group of believers who you trust, respect and are able to give you wise counsel.

God provides care through community and shows His love for us:

- We all want and need someone that will provide care for us.
- Through community and care we understand God's love for us through caring for each other.
- When we do life with other believers we can acknowledge God's love for us and that love leads us to worship.
- God uses people (Romans 12:3-8) and the gifts He gives to care for His people and that care is a direct reflection of His love for us.
- He cared enough to carry out His plan for us through community.

These are some of the key points that I shared at our latest leadership training. I hope they will get you thinking about the community God has established for you. May you continue to grow, gain knowledge and wise counsel, and see God's love for you here at WBC.
