dear church,

Brothers and Sisters,

We had an amazing C5 Leadership Seminar. These seminars are the highest level of leadership training we offer at WBC. We do this because we know that as our church continues to grow, reaching new people and impacting new areas of Maryland and beyond, we must continue to grow spiritually and as leaders. It's amazing to see how many people will sacrifice a Friday evening to grow with us in these ways! We do this so that we create the best ministries here at WBC for you and your family to grow in Christ.

One of the seminar's main points was: "Ministry is the furnace for maturity." Serving isn't just for those who have 'arrived' because it is how God shapes us into mature disciples. We wrestled with, "Platforms don't build mature disciples, combat boots do." In other words, real growth happens on the frontlines of battle, not just on Sundays.

I challenged our leaders to use ministry "mirrors" to see ourselves honestly because ministry reveals our blind spots, tests our integrity, and refines our gifts. We challenged our leaders that "Arrogance likes mirrors too much. Insecurity hates mirrors. But humility utilizes mirrors." My prayer is that we would be leaders who grow by extending grace to the reality of ourselves so that we can grow into the truth of what God says about us.

Kaycee and Kim challenged us to see that we can serve one another well when we are thriving in the spiritual gifts God has blessed us with! Barb and Cat challenged us to shift from simply delegating tasks to truly deploying people. The early church grew because leaders "released others to serve." Let's create space for new leaders to flourish, not just fill roles in our ministry.

We also spent time in God's Word, prayer, and praising together. It's a good reminder that: "Sunday faith won't shake the gates of hell." Our calling is to live out our faith every day, in every sphere of life, not just having a "faith" on Sunday.

I encourage you to reflect on your strengths and weaknesses, seek God's help to grow, and look for ways to empower others. Together, and in God's grace, we can build a church where leaders multiply and all of us mature in Christ.


