dear church,

Brothers and Sisters,

My heart is full with encouragement as I have been blessed to see how God is working in so many of your lives. As we've walked through Philippians together, God has reminded us that we are already clean. That promise alone allows us to recognize filthy scraps and confess them: to God and to others. I pray we find the confidence to be honest, to repent without fear, and to let go of what can never satisfy.

As God exposes the filthy scraps we so easily pursue in success, comfort, control, money and pleasure, I pray we will see them for what they are: "a loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord (Phil. 3:8). They may not be inherently sinful things, but they are not sufficient for true life and they will leave you empty. There is someone greater, Paul calls it the heavenly call to the goal/prize, which is knowing Christ in the way that leads to righteousness and resurrection.

This is a life-giving pursuit of Christ. Think about this: in Christ, our life has purpose, our repentance is not shameful but hopeful, and God is not finished with us; we have not arrived. God's Word is clear, a life set on the world—especially sinful distortions of the stomach, sex, and pleasures—will lead to destruction. But, a life in pursuit of Christ, with Christ, and through Christ will lead to joy in the midst of suffering (4:4), gentleness in the midst of a harsh world (4:4), peace in the midst of chaos (4:7), overcoming anxiety (4:6), contentment despite loss (4:12), and ultimately resurrection despite death (3:21)! What greater hope is there in this world than those promises in the gospel of Jesus Christ?

Seriously, 'think' about it. Jesus' life, death, and resurrection leads us to have what the whole world is longing for and can't find (aside from evildoers and dogs in Phil. 3...don't be them, they cause chaos and pain) So... Who doesn't want joy? Who doesn't want peace? Who doesn't want eternal life? People run to pleasures for false joy. People trust in fallen humans for the promise of peace. People trust in healthcare to provide eternal life. Yet the gospel promises not an easy life, but life in the midst of every suffering this world throws at us! I can see why Paul says that to live is Christ, and to die is gain. In Christ, with Christ, and through Christ, we lack nothing.

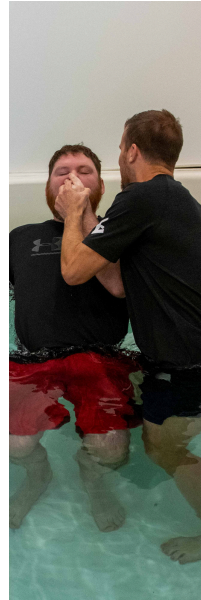

Haiti Update

After almost 2 months, the meals are ready for release from customs! **Glory to God!** Over the next month Zeal Mission Society will work with a network of local logistics providers to move the meals in phases to two groups in the metro area of Port-au-Prince. Additionally, Zeal Mission Society will send a mission team to Cap Haitien in April to facilitate additional food distribution to orphanages in the northeast communities of Haiti and continue business as mission training. Please pray for transformed hearts for all those involved.

SPECIAL NOTE: While you pray, if you are called to serve on the ground in Haiti, please reach out to Scott to better understand how to be involved in WBC's next upcoming mission project in Cap Haitien, Haiti. God has opened many doors to continue WBC's ministry in Haiti so far; however, there is much more to be done.
